



2020 ESF Scholarship Application Questions

It is recommended that you prepare your application as a word document before loading it into the online application because the form does not allow you to save a partially completed application.

The online application form requires the following information:

- Personal details
- Name of a professional referee

Note that the following all have a 250 word limit

- What do you wish to study?
- What background work have you done to determine that this study is required and will be of value to the sector in Victoria?
- Why are you particularly interested in this topic?
- What are three objectives you want to achieve from the study?
- Where do you propose undertaking this study and why have you selected these locations?
- What preliminary contact have you made with the people or agencies you wish to visit?
- Is there support for your application from within your agency?
- How will the knowledge you gain from this study be translated to add value to the Victorian emergency management sector?
- Have you previously planned and undertaken any sort of independent research study? If so, provide a brief description.

Applicants also need to provide an indication of:

- Travel dates
- Travel insurance quote
- Air travel quote
- Expected costs associated with land travel
- Number of nights away from home where accommodation and living allowance is required
